

INSTRUCTION TO AUTHORS

Agriculture for Sustainable Development is published in the month of June and December. At the same time, it appears in electronic format on website: (<http://www.sustainableagriculture.in>) giving free access to the full text, for a greater international visibility of the authors and the journal. The manuscripts must be written in English. The Editorial Committee and referees are all outstanding national and foreign researchers. The Editorial Board decides on the acceptance or rejection of a paper, and appeals are not accepted.

FORMAT

Original articles should represent a true contribution to scientific knowledge and should not be submitted simultaneously to other journals. Writing style should be clear, concise, and precise. The length must not exceed 15 typed pages for the research articles, reviews and mini reviews sections, 6-8 typed pages for short communication. Manuscripts are accepted in MS Word format only. All the articles must be submitted via email attachment. Use letter size paper, 12 point Times New Roman, 2.5 cm margins all around, Manuscripts should be prepared with numbered lines, with wide margins and double spacing throughout, i.e. also for abstracts, footnotes and references. Every page of the manuscript, including the title page, references, tables, etc. should be numbered.

TITLE

Title of article should be informative, comprehensive and self-explanatory. It should be set in capitalized, using one font size higher than the remaining text. The title should indicate the scientific name of the crops or organisms studied, wherever relevant. The name and address of author(s) should include the name of the institution, city, country and pin code. When a paper has several authors from different institutions, key the author to the address with superscript Arabic numerals. Corresponding author address and email should be given as a footnote.

ABSTRACT

The abstract, written in complete sentences, should not have more than 250 words. It should contain a very brief account of the materials, methods, results and discussion. It thus gives: the 1-2 major results using precise trends and data, then the interpretation of those results, then the claimed novelty of those results versus current knowledge followed by the basic or applied benefits of those results for sustainable development of agriculture.

KEY WORDS:

Key words (indexing terms), normally 4 - 6 items, alphabetically arrange.

INTRODUCTION

The introduction part should be brief and limited to the statement of the importance of the study, problem or the aim of the experiment. This section should argue the case for your study, outlining only essential background, but should not include either the findings or the conclusions. It should not be a review of the subject area, but should finish with a clear statement of the question being addressed. Please provide a context for the report with respect to previous work done in the field. The literature should be cited.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

The materials and methods will include experimental design and the techniques employed. Where the methods are well known, the citation of a standard work is sufficient. All modifications of procedures must be explained. Experimental materials and statistical models should be described clearly and fully with references.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

This section should present the data as clearly as possible. Authors are encouraged to describe the rationale for the experimental design, but extensive interpretations must be reserved for the Discussion. Please avoid redundancy in the presentation of data. Results in the form of a figure may not be presented additionally as a table or vice versa. It should give the main conclusions from the experimental data without repeating them in length, and should interpret them with respect to relevant literature. Self-explanatory tables should be typed on separate sheets and carry appropriate titles. The tabular matter should not exceed 30% of the text. Any abbreviation used in a table must be defined in that table.

With the exception of typographical errors, no changes will be made in the manuscript at the proof stage.
